

Preparing to stay at Camp

What to pack!

ITEMS TO PACK

- All medications (prescription and over-the-counter) brought to camp must be in their original containers and clearly labeled to turn into the camp health care personnel.
- Sleeping bag or bedding and pillow
 - Not needed for Oasis (formerly Special Needs) or Family Camps at Pine Lake
- Towels/washcloths
- Toothbrush/toothpaste/soap/deodorant/etc.
 - Please pack in a Ziplock bag or cosmetic bag
- T-shirts and shorts
- Long-sleeved shirt and one pair of long pants
- One set of clothes for messy activities
- Swimsuit (modest)/beach towel
- Jacket and/or sweatshirt
- Closed-toe shoes/sneakers with socks are required for most activities and general wear
- Rain gear
- Bible
- Favorite book or devotional materials
- Pencil/paper/flashlight (new batteries)
- Insect repellent/sunscreen
- Reusable water bottle

LEAVE IT HOME

All Campers:

Do not bring personal sports equipment which requires special storage, such as archery or climbing equipment. **The following items will be immediately confiscated, and parents will be called.** Fireworks, firearms, drugs (including prescription drugs that aren't yours), alcohol, knives, weapons, cigarettes, and pets. If you are unsure if something is permitted, please call the Camping Office at 608-296-2720.

Youth Campers & Oasis (formerly Special Needs) Campers:

Leave cell phones at home! With increased technology that may infringe on the privacy of our campers, we do not allow cell phones to remain with campers. Questions about this policy can be directed to the site directors.

Do not bring candy, gum, or other food. It invites unwanted critters into the cabins.

Do not bring electronic items: computers, iPods/Pads, tablets, and electronic games. We cannot be responsible for loss, theft, or damage of personal items. **Electronics will be collected, labeled and returned at the end of camping session if brought to camp.**

HEALTH FORM INFORMATION

The Board of Camp & Retreat Ministries Camping Committee requires that campers have a completed health form on file with us before attending camp. The intent of this information is so camp health care staff can be aware of camper's needs and provide appropriate care. Completed health forms need to be provided annually.

Oasis campers must have a medical exam performed by a physician, physician's assistant, or registered nurse within 12 months prior to the camp start date.

Complete health form online or send directly to the camp site 2 weeks prior to your camp start date.
